

Purpose

A recount:

- Retells past events or experiences.
- · Sequences events in the order they happened

Examples

Personal stories, journals, factual recounts, newspaper articles, imaginative recounts

Framework

- Setting (Orientation)Who? What? Where? When? Why?
- Events in time order (Body)
 Detail events what happened in chronological order
- Conclusion (Ending)
 What did you think, feel or decide about the events that happened?

Recount tips

- Set the scene who what where when why
- Write about the events in the order they happened
- Start a new paragraph fro each event
- End with a comment

Word Features

- Time connectives
 - Yesterday, when, after, during, later, finally
- Dynamic action verbs
 - Went, watched, built, found, walked
- Adjectives to add interest
 - Pleasant, vast, sizzling, gigantic, hilarious

Word Features

Tense

Past – had, caught, gave, rode, told

Style

- Personal
- First Person
